The **Media Plaza** conference centre is situated in the **Jaarbeurs complex**. Jaarbeurs is located in the centre of Utrecht, right next to the Central Station and within walking distance of the historical city centre. This makes Jaarbeurs easy to reach, both by public transport and by car.

When you arrive at the location, take the **escalators in the central lobby** of the hall complex of Jaarbeurs **up to the second floor** where you will find the **Media Plaza** conference centre. Please check the attached floor map for orientation.

If you arrive **by train**, from the **Central Station**, follow the signs that read 'Jaarbeursplein'. It is a five-minute walk to the venue of the Jaarbeurs. From Schiphol Airport to Utrecht Centraal there are 72 direct trains per day. Fares range 10-15€. Ride takes some 30 minutes. For the full train timetable/schedule check <https://www.ns.nl/en>.





If you are travelling **by car**, please navigate to the following adress: **Truus van Lierlaan 1, 3527 KZ**. Follow the blue ANWB signs that read 'Jaarbeurs' from the Utrecht Ring Road. Jaarbeurs has ample parking space on its own grounds in the centre of Utrecht.

### Venue

The **Media Plaza** is one of the most modern and innovative conference and meeting locations in Europe. It consists of 17 session rooms and 3 foyers. For our event we have the Auditorium, Barzone and session rooms available. The plenary and parallel sessions, the reception, lunch, dinner and an after-drink will be at the same location.
